WHAT DO YOU NEED?



OPTIONS FOR SUBMISSION

The taxpayer's packet must be mailed or turned in at a Taxpayer Assistance Center (TAC).


- Taxpayer mails in original documents.
- Taxpayer makes an in-person appointment at a TAC.
- Taxpayer works with AA (who mails in original documents).
- Taxpayer works with CAA (who mails in copies of originals).



WHAT THE INSTRUCTIONS DON'T TELL YOU

INCOMPLETE INSTRUCTIONS

- Exceptions to expiration date requirement not included
- Incorrect explanation of proof of residency requirement for dependents from Mexico
- "Original" not clearly defined (or consistently enforced)





All ITIN applicants must prove identity and foreign status.

- Passport can fulfill both requirements.
- Otherwise, must submit a combination of two documents from the list.
- All documents (other than birth certificate) must have an expiration date and be unexpired.
- Exceptions to this requirement (per IRM 3.21.263.6.3.4.2.2):
 - Some Honduran national ID cards
 - Some foreign driver's licenses
 - Mexican voter ID cards issued before 2008



PROOF OF RESIDENCY REQ.

Proof of residency required for most dependents:

- Some proof of residency options:
 - School record
 - Medical record (under 6 yrs)
 - Date of entry stamp or I-94

- Bank statement
- Utility bill
- Rental contract
- Exception for (1) dependents from Mexico or Canada not claimed for the Credit for Other Dependents and (2) dependents of US military personnel stationed overseas

WHAT IS "ORIGINAL?"

Should it be signed? Stamped? Sealed?

Examples:

- School records
- Medical records
- Bank statement
- Utility bill
- Rental contract



TIPS FOR SUCCESS

CONFIRM ALLOWABLE TAX BENEFIT

For spouse, this is the MFJ standard deduction.

For dependents, this may include:

- Head of Household filing status
- Credit for Other Dependents
- American Opportunity Tax Credit
- Premium Tax Credit
- Child and Dependent Care Credit

AVOID THESE ERRORS

- Required fields left blank
- X Applicant name does not match name on W-2
- X Redacted SSN on W-2 for ITIN holder
- X Primary name and TIN incorrect in top section of W-7

I ENSURE PASSPORT IS SIGNED

Less common error but still important.

If the applicant was a minor when the passport issued but is now an adult, they must sign the passport.
